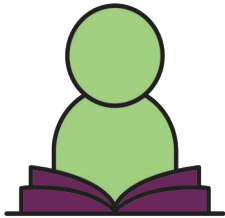

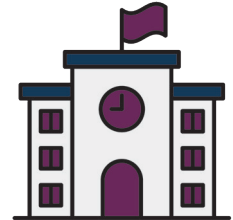
Student
